FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

February has been a busy month and we are in March already. The weather is changing but we might experience more cold as Easter has not happened yet. I pray you and your family are doing well.

I mentioned in a sermon the "revival" that broke out in Asbury University in Kentucky. There has been a lot of discussion on this happening and also questions as to whether this is a work of God or not. It finally came to an end as the university decided to go back to their schedule. Someone sent me a text message that said, "Looks like the school in Asbury, KY met their revival quota." I must agree because even though this happening brought people together in a good way, what was absent was more discernable than what was present. There was no preaching of the precious Gospel, no brokenness, little repentance, and no evidence that lasting change had taken place.

It is good to worship our God and King. We should and singing along with prayer is always a good thing. Jonathan Edwards, who experienced the Great Awakening, wrote that what happened in his day was a "surprising" work of God. It was not planned or promoted. God sent it and the nation was impacted in a godly way. I pray we will always put the Scripture before any experience.

Our culture has largely ignored this happening in Kentucky. Most of the liberal news outlets ignored and skipped what was called a revival. The outlets that covered the event were mostly either conservative or decidedly Christian. Some have said that what happened at Asbury would bring in the last days. Rather than read and study Scripture, some would rather interpret Scripture by what is happening in the world. That is completely backwards. We do not need current events to interpret the Word of God. When this does not bring in the last days of human history, I guess they will look for some other happening.

I am very skeptical about what some call a revival. I do want to see souls saved and repentance happening. I also want to see the church involved in making disciples of all the nations. God is at work all around us. We see where He is at work and join Him.

I am thankful for the ministries at O'Brien Baptist Church. We are reaching out to the world through our efforts to fulfil the Great Commission. May God use us to do His will until He comes! *Pastor Keith Jones*

MUSIC NOTES

The English word 'sing' is used 143 times in the Bible. There are 11 different Hebrew words and 3 different Greek words for our one English word 'sing'. 'Singing' coupled with 'thanksgiving' is used 12 times. 'Sing' coupled with 'exult' is used 9 times. 'Sing' coupled with 'praise' is used 63 times. 'Shout' or 'Sing' for joy is used 36 times. "I will sing" is used 52 times. The command to sing is used 58 times. So, what does this tell us? At the very least, it should tell us that God views singing is an important act of praise and worship. Have you ever tried singing when you really just didn't feel like it? What happened? Most likely after awhile you began to feel like singing! Funny how that works! Try it this month and see how it changes your attitude. Psalm 33:1 says "Rejoice in the LORD, you righteous ones; Praise is becoming and appropriate for those who are upright in heart." God wants to hear your praise, so sing out!!

We are finished (for now) with singing the books of the Bible. Keep practicing at home and soon you will find that you can find your way around the Bible much easier. We will begin learning The Beatitudes in March. There's not many so it won't take long to learn these beautiful verses.

The choir has been working hard on new songs and on improving their tone quality. Thank you to those who have given us encouragement and your appreciation. That means a lot to people who work hard at what they do. Give a choir member a pat on the back. They don't sing in order to get praise from men; they sing to give praise to God. But an "I appreciate it" goes a long way.

LIBRARY NEWS


